The Butternut

We found a butternut in the garden and had a butternut but first we had to bake it.

First we cut in the butternut in half. Next we cut off the stalk and scooped the seeds out and cut it into 4 quarters. We put it in the tray. We could all have a piece. We put olive oil on it. We put it in the oven and put it on 200 degrees and put it in the oven for 1 hour.

How to Roast a Beautiful and Delicious Butternut

Yesterday Te Awa roasted a butternut. We found the butternut in the Leigh School garden.

Now we will show you how to roast a butternut. Let's begin. First you cut the butternut in half. Next you cut off the stalk. Then you scoop the seeds out of the butternut. Fourthly you cut the butternut into 4 quarters. Then you slip the 4 quarters into the tray. After that you pour olive oil all over the 4 quarters and mix the olive oil on top of all the 4 quarters

Last of all you put it in the oven. You put the oven on 200 degrees and put it in for 1 hour. Once you get the 4 quarters out after an hour it will be delicious.

So now you know how to roast a butternut.
