Proposed work list :

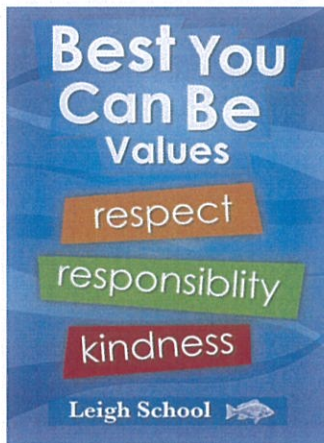
1. Clear space in Teacher Aide room
