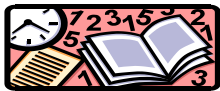

This week we welcome Minna Reid-Serna to Te Waipuna. We also welcome Maite and Richard, Minna’s parents, to our Leigh School Community.

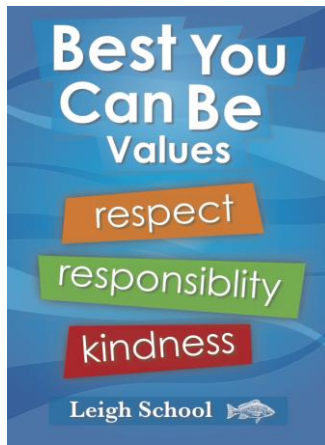
Reminder
