Tena koutou,

Well, we've really hit the ground running this week, with our visit to the Discovery Centre yesterday, class / individual and family photographs today and our "Shake Out" earthquake drill tomorrow morning - and it's only week one!!

Thank you to all the parents who assisted with transport yesterday (at short notice). The visit was the launch of our inquiry into salps in which we will be working with Claudio Aguayo from the University of Auckland, Moira Decima from NIWA and Tim Haggitt from the Discovery Centre. The longer term aim of the inquiry, which will cover two terms, is to develop an app that can be used to record sightings of salps as these simple but vital organisms assist with the absorption of co2 from the atmosphere.

Hopefully, by the end of our inquiry, our children will be able to teach us more interesting facts and information as they continue their learning throughout the two terms.

The "Shake Out" tomorrow is a national earthquake drill. The school and pre-school and other organisations within the community will be practicing the 'drop, cover, hold' procedure which they need to use in the unlikely event of an earthquake. It would also be helpful, at this time, to consider how you would respond at home should there be an earthquake and possible tsunami.


Friends Of Leigh – Leigh Summer Festival – 9th February, 2019


