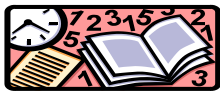

Tena koutou,

Thank you to all those who have paid promptly for stationery - it has meant that children can get straight into their class programmes and their learning.

As part of the stationery list, there is a charge for 'Photocopying and consumables' – this is a donation that covers items that the children use in school – such as photocopy paper (worksheets), stickers, tissues, sunblock, etc. The voluntary donation that each family pays (\$65 per child or \$100 for a family) goes directly into school funding to supplement what the Ministry of Education provides us with to run the school.

Te Moana and Te Awa also have a charge for 'Hapara' which is an online type portfolio in which each child can work on and save their writing, reading or maths work and access it at home – if you have internet available.

Other expenses that may crop up over the year include:

- individual items of stationery that children run out of e.g rulers or rubbers. (Teachers have also organized for children to purchase a box of pencils as part of their stationery, which should last them for the whole year).
- PR1ME maths books which you may need to purchase as your child moves up levels. Children do their Maths work in these books and they are proving far more manageable for children and teachers.
