Disco

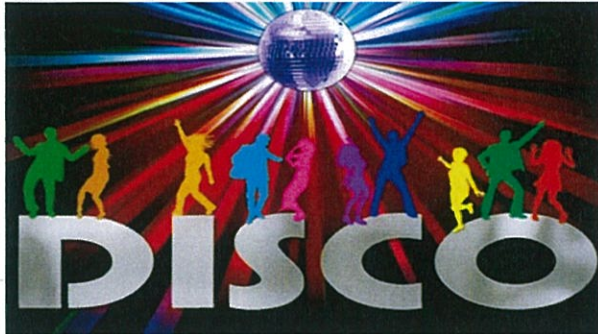

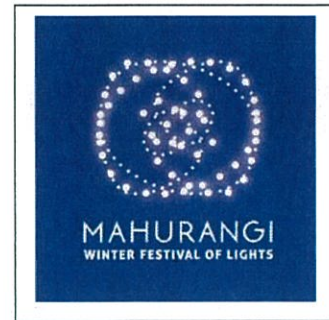
