Auckland Art Gallery Trip

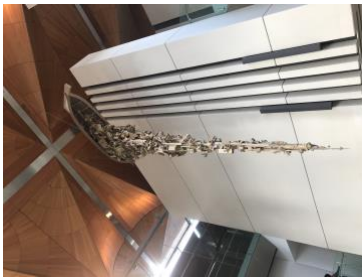
